## WHO IS SMART?

SMART (Suburban Mobility Authority for Regional Transportation) is the regional public transit provider serving communities across Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb counties. Through SMART's Community Partnership Program, SMART provides funding and vehicles to cities, townships, and local transit providers across Wayne County.

## WHAT IS COMMUNITY TRANSIT?

Community transit uses small buses and vans, often the vehicles residents see operating in their local community, to take people from their homes to grocery stores, medical appointments, senior centers, and other everyday destinations.

## COMMUNITY PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: LIV&GO

- » Livonia currently utilizes 8 SMART-provided vehicles to support Liv&Go service.
- » Liv&Go provided more than 13,800 rides for seniors in 2025.
- » Liv&Go provided more than 11,600 rides for people with disabilities in 2025.
- » Overall, Liv&Go, in partnership with SMART, provided more than 27,000 rides in 2025.

## BUILDING ON THE LIV&GO PARTNERSHIP

**If the millage is successful, SMART and the City of Livonia are committed to working together to develop a Pilot Program that combines SMART FLEX on-demand service with the existing Liv&Go local transit service. By bringing these services together, all residents will have one, easier-to-use transportation option with more hours of service, greater flexibility in booking rides, and better connections to the broader regional transit network.**

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

Wayne County voters will decide on the transit millage on **August 4, 2026**. If approved, the millage will provide funding to maintain existing transit services and expand support for community transit programs.
